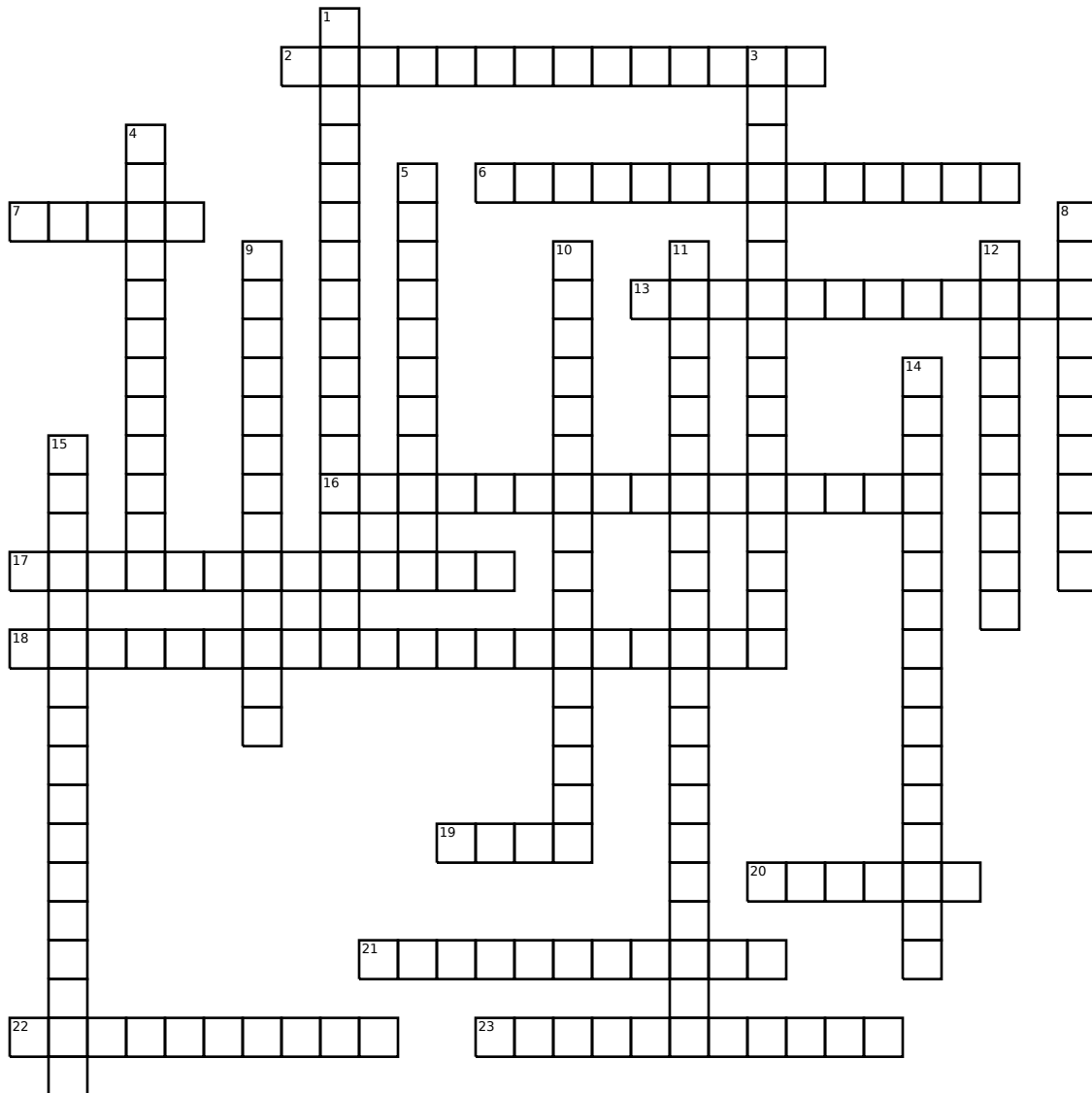

- 2 Removes an Active Directory group.
 - 6 Creates a new Active Directory computer.

 - 13 Creates an Active Directory object.
 - 16 Enables an Active Directory account.
 - 17 Moves an Active Directory object or a container of objects to a different container or domain.
 - 18 Gets one or more Active Directory service accounts.
 - 19 Creates a new Active Directory OU.
New-ADOrganizationalBLANK
 - 20 Removes one or more members from an Active Directory group.
Remove-ADGroupBLANK
 - 21 Modifies an Active Directory group.

 - 3 Unlocks an Active Directory account.
 - 4 A String that specifies the scope of an Active Directory search.
